
















## Prints – Prints – Prints

10:45 am	<b>We walk to the gallery.</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If weather and ground conditions permit, our walk will include a close-up look at the Inukshuk and other Artwork</li> </ul>	 

11:00 am	<p><b>Inside the Gallery:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In the lobby, we hang up our coats/jackets and store our belongings in the gallery lockers.</li> <li>• Then we go into the gallery rooms to look at Inuit art.</li> <li>• We can explore and touch an artist's printing stone.</li> <li>• When we finish looking at art, we get our belongings and walk back to the Pine Cottage.</li> </ul>

11:50 am	<p><b>We make prints (use foam board, printing ink, inscribing tools, etc.)</b></p> <p>1. Together we learn and practice:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ways to use the inscribing tools and apply colour to the foam board.</li> <li>• How to make the print - place, press, and lift the printing paper.</li> </ul> <p>2. Make your own prints.</p> <p>Some samples (just for ideas):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• When you are finished, you can make your own stamp!</li> <li>• Use scratch foam, pencils, and paint to create a stamp and print it on illustration board.</li> </ul>
