Figure Drawing / Painting

Pine Cottage, McMichael Gallery

In this class we will be working from professional female and male models. We will begin with simple yet effective exercises that will help you master the basics then go on to creating drawings or paintings of the human figure in the medium of your choice. Andrew Sookrah will conduct demonstrations in various media and styles with running commentary on the process. Elements of proportion and the connectivity of all elements of the human form will be explored as participants progress to effective uses of line, dramatic light, shadow & shading, and colour. Andrew Sookrah will provide guidance and support to participants along their unique path of creative expression in the medium of their choice. Guidance will be offered for charcoal, pencil, oils (traditional or water mixable), acrylic or watercolour.
