This is a SOFT pastel workshop. Please do not bring oil pastels. Please contact Margaret before substituting brands. \*\*Purchasing the right type of pastels is a crucial part of the technique you will learn in this workshop. Note: Margaret will have an inventory of pastels that can be purchased from her in class. Contact Margaret for details.

#### Papers:

- 1) A selection (minimum 4 sheets) of *Canson Mi-Tientes* pastel paper size 19"x26". Please choose some light, medium and dark papers. Most people tend to stay with greys and beiges, but you are encouraged to bring any colour, pure, bright, crazy, whatever turns you on! Select at least 1 light value, 1 medium value, 1 dark value, and 1 other colour that you love.
- 2) 1 sheet of *BFK, Stonehenge* or similar weight printmaking paper.
- 3) 5-6 sheets of newsprint

#### Pastels:

- 1) A minimum set of 12 *NU Pastels* (if you want to go bigger, by all means!)
- 2) *Rembrandt* pastels: you have a choice of purchasing their smallest set (15 half sticks) or purchasing individual sticks. You have that option, as you will have a better selection of colours for mixing. They are whole sticks, as follows:

#### Other items:

- 1) Kneaded eraser
- 2) Vine charcoal
- 3) Masking tape
- 4) 1 sheet of foamcore (Dollarama)
- 5) Tin foil (small amount, 24")
- 6) Tracing paper or a roll of wax paper
- 7) One piece of sand paper

**Optional items:** an old bristle brush, baby wipes, bull dog or other clips, paper towel, sketch pad to draw in or make notes.

**Recommended art supply stores:** *Curry's Artists' Materials, Above Ground Art Supplies, DeSerres, & Gwartzman's Art Supplies.* Call your nearest location first to make sure they have a selection of what you are looking for. Ask to speak to someone in the paper and drawing section to make sure you speak with someone knowledgeable.
